



## Bob Dudley

Bob Dudley is a businessman committed to addressing the world's climate challenges and accelerating the global energy transition. He is active on corporate boards, a leader of energy industry organizations, and recent founder of a solar development company. He retired in 2020 as CEO of BP. He holds dual American and British citizenship.

Since 2015, Mr. Dudley has been chair of the international, industry-led Oil and Gas Climate Initiative (OGCI), an industry group of more than a dozen companies, representing over 30% of global production. OGCI is committed to taking practical actions on climate change. Related to this and other successes, he was named the 2018 Petroleum Executive of the Year by Energy Intelligence. In August 2022 Bob was appointed to the board of 8 Rivers Capital, a world-leading Net Zero Solutions provider.

Bob joined the board of directors of LyondellBasell, one of the largest chemical companies in the world, effective May 2021. He is a member of the finance and safety committees. In April 2021, Bob joined the board of directors of Freeport-McMoRan, a global international copper mining company. He is a member of the governance and safety committees. Also in 2021, he was named chair of the board of Axio, a private cyber risk quantification company. He is on the Energy Advisory Board for the Kingdom of Bahrain. He chairs Accenture's Global Energy board and in August 2022 became vice chair for Prism Global Management LLC a private equity company. He is a member of the Business Council and a fellow of the Royal Academy of Engineering.

Specific to his commitment to the energy transition, Bob founded Dudley Solar Developments, LLC in May 2021, a company focused on managing, financing, and developing solar systems for large customers.

Mr. Dudley held the position of CEO at BP from 2010 to 2020. Under Bob's leadership, the global energy provider focused on the dual challenge of providing more energy with fewer greenhouse gas emissions. Bob had a distinguished career with BP and its predecessors spanning over 40 years, serving in a broad range of engineering, commercial, strategic, international, and executive roles, gaining significant experience in strategic planning, risk

management, international operations, HSE, and operations matters. He was appointed to the BP board in 2009 with accountability for the Americas and Asia. Previous executive roles included leadership of the Alternative and Renewable Energy businesses and for BP's upstream business in Russia, the Caspian region, and Africa. From 2003 to 2008, Bob was based in Moscow as President and CEO of TNK-BP.

Mr. Dudley holds dual American and British citizenship. He earned an MBA from Southern Methodist University, an MIM from the Thunderbird School of International Management (now part of Arizona State), and a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from the University of Illinois.
